## VBC

- Be aware of the time left for your submission and plan accordingly.
- Formulate and devise as detailed of a game plan as possible, and make sure to incorporate alternate strategies in case your plans go awry.
- Make sure there are no distractions when you are completing your simulation— every second counts.
- Make sure you are thinking outside of the box.
- Spend a decent amount of time learning and researching the simulation.
- Make sure you look at the guidelines for the simulations prior to beginning.
- For the Stock Market Game, learning how to manage stress, fear, and success is something you will need in order to be proud of your investments, and eventually obtain success.

## SMG (Stock Market Game)

- Walk through each trade/decision you made and conjure up the scene when you were making the decision— What informed your decision (i.e. Which articles, etc.)?
- Utilize your resources, whether it's websites, blogs, etc. that can help you decide which stocks to buy
- Research about the stock markets before buying, it's important to make informed decisions about your stocks!
- Looking at Wall Street Bets can be helpful, and investing in good stocks can help when taking advantage of how volatile it is
- When the stock falls, you can make a lot of profit by shorting it!
