Setting Up for the School Year

- -Make sure that your advisor completes all necessary affiliation & registration steps.
- -Presidents: If you haven't already, make sure to fill out the Presidents' Council contact information form at https://californiadeca.org/resources/presidents-council/, so that you'll receive reminders for our monthly Presidents' Council Meetings where Team 73 will share updates alongside the success & accomplishments of all chapters. Most presidents have already filled this out, if you recall filling it out at all, don't worry about it!
- -All chapter officers: Join the California DECA Chapter Officer Slack server, at https://join.slack.com/t/californiadeca/shared_invite/zt-1zki308d2-0IZ0UGbxUGvvX4CK5p_Tpg. This Slack server is primarily used for quick communication between chapters officers and the state team, so feel free to say anything that's professionally adept! State Officers will be posting reminders & information that are specific to chapter officers. More formal communication will still take place via email, but Slack will act as a supplement most of the time.

Key Dates

-The first Presidents Council meeting will be held on the second Monday of each month from 7:30 P.M - 8:30 P.M starting 9/11 (reminders will be sent out). The dates that the Presidents Council will be held on include: 9/11/2023, 10/9/2023, 11/13/2023, 12/11/2023, at each respective district conference in January, and 2/12/2024. The Zoom link is leadable.info/cadecaprescouncil2324. It will be sent to Presidents' via email and Slack alongside reminders and any changes.



-Power trip is on November 17-19th 2023 in Austin, Texas. Registration will open September 14th at https://www.deca.org/conferences/power, it'll be due on October 18th 2023. The Power Trip is a great way to relax, network, and build professional skills with members across DECA on a smaller and more personal scale than ICDC. Also, it's a great way to travel as ICDC is held in Anaheim this year!

-The first Champ Camp will be held via a Zoom webinar format on 10/2/23 at 7:30 P.M, the Zoom link will be published via Instagram, emailed to all presidents, and Slack. After that, it'll be held bi-monthly on the first Monday: 12/4/2023, 2/5/2024, 4/01/2024. Champ Camp are interviews with past ICDC winners sharing tips to succeed in various events.
